You may have to pay Capital Gains Tax so plan ahead! Capital Gains Tax Payment is due on 31st January 2023 for assets sold in December 2022. There are exemptions to this tax, make sure you understand which assets are liable by clicking [here](#).

FEBRUARY

Thinking about buying a new home this year?
